NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- **1.2** The prescriptions of the RYA will apply.
- **1.3** Racing rule(s) 27.1, A4, 62.1(a), 28.1, 30.1, 61.3, 62.2, 60.1(a), 64.3(a), Race Signals will be changed. The changes appear in full in the sailing instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **2.1** The regatta is open to boats of the GP14 class.
- **2.1** All boats shall have a valid Class Certificate of registration and measurement issued prior to the commencement of this event.
- **2.2** Each helm must be a paid-up member of the GP14 Class International Association.
- **2.3** Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form on arrival at the club, together with the required fee of: £50.00
- 2.4 Registration and payment of entry fee should be made on-line at East Antrim Boat Club website (www.eabc.club) before Saturday 23rd October and preferably by 1800hrs on Thursday 21st October 2021.

3 SCHEDULE

- **3.1** Registration will be online at <u>www.eabc.club</u> prior to the event
- **3.2** 6 Races are scheduled:

Saturday 23rd October – up to 4 races Sunday 24th October – up to 4 races

3.3 The scheduled time of the first warning signals will be:

Saturday 23 rd	^d October	1200 hrs
Sunday 24 th	October	1100 hrs

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available online at <u>www.eabc.club</u> and at registration on Saturday morning.

5 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Gold Fleet 1st, 2nd and 3rd Silver Fleet 1st, 2nd and 3rd Bronze Fleet

Association Trophies shall be held by the winners and returned by them (in good time and in good order) to the Organisers of the event in the following year. The winners shall be responsible for engraving the trophies. Any GP14 Association Trophies presented shall not be removed from Ireland.

6 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

7 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 Pounds Sterling or the equivalent.

8 COVID

Anyone who is experiencing Covid-19 symptoms i.e., a cough, fever, loss of taste or smell or who has been in contact with someone experiencing the symptoms or who has had a positive Covid-19 test MUST NOT TRAVEL TO THE EVENT.

Inside the Clubhouse

- Please sign into the clubhouse on arrival (available at the main Club entrance or at the bar)
- Please wear a mask when entering and leaving the clubhouse. Visitors are reminded to wear a face covering, unless exempt, at all times other than when they are seated.
- In accordance with recent regulation updates, customers may go to the bar to place orders or pay. However, in indoor settings, customers will still be required to return to their table to consume their food or drink.
